	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GFWC Challenge:</b></p> <p>Sponsor a Youth Art Contest, preferably in March during Youth Art Month.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GFWC Georgia Challenge:</b></p> <p>Sponsor a Youth Art Contest during Youth Art Month in March, Provide contest rules, judges, and prizes for winners. Encourage community members to become involved. Display artwork at a public venue.</p>

	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GFWC Challenge:</b></p> <p>Support and aid women veterans in your community.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GFWC Georgia Challenge:</b></p> <p>Support/aid/celebrate women veterans during the first two weeks of November. Find the nearest Veterans Hospital/Clinic. Contact Women Veterans Program Manager for direction in assisting women. Sponsor a collection for make-up, feminine hygiene items, or toiletries. Donate items to VA hospitals/clinics for distribution. Sponsor a “Missing Woman” table at a club luncheon or partner with a local restaurant to do so. Donate phone cards to the USO for women veterans. Recognize women veterans in the community.</p>

	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GFWC Challenge:</b></p> <p>Support STEM programs and activities for Special Needs Students.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GFWC Georgia Challenge:</b></p> <p>Create and participate in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) Programs for students with disabilities during October (Disability History Month).</p>

	<h2>ENVIRONMENT</h2>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GFWC Challenge:</b> Reduce plastics use – refuse, reuse, repurpose, recycle.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>GFWC Georgia Challenge:</b> Create, build, and produce something usable from anything plastic (bags, bottles, etc.). The more plastic used, the more points will be awarded, so tally the amount collected and utilized. The final product will be documented through photographs from beginning to end. Submit 5 pictures with report. Certificates will be given each year to a first, second, and third place winner.</p>
